In addition Itu has been working alongside local Marine Resources staff to set up a Bonefish reserve on Aitutaki so that this sport can be enjoyed for many generations.

## TOUR HIGHLIGHTS

**Professional Presentation** - Guide and Tour Operator Marshal Humphrey has extensive knowledge of the Geography and History of the island and this shows in the way he presents his commentary along the trek. Discussions on the formation of the upraised limestone structure and the many fossilised shells and marine crustaceans during the tour is very interesting.

**Decent to Anatakitaki** - The short decent to the entrance to Anatakitaki Cave reveals an underground world of interesting limestone structures and small oasis-like growth of coconut trees and birdsnest ferns. All around the landing are a network of small caverns. Photographers will enjoy being here.

### Anatakitaki Cave - Home of the Kopeka Bird

The experience is truly special. The birds echo locating sonar is incredible. Simply by letting out a shrill clicking sound, the Kopeka is able to use the reverberated echo of this sound to navigate its way around the dark cave. Even to locate its tiny nest on the ledge of the cave.

**Water cavern Swim** - The swim in the underground water cavern is refreshing and a great way to end the cave tour.
